The CIBC President's Indigenous Achievement Award is available to Indigenous students, who demonstrate high achievement in disciplines related to Science, Technology, Environmental Science, Math, or Indigenous Studies.

WHO QUALIFIES? You must meet all the following criteria:

- Demonstrated high achievement in disciplines related to Science, Technology, Environmental Science, Math, or Indigenous Studies. High achievement is defined as hardworking and successful.
- Students must self-identify as an Indigenous student (which includes First Nation (status and non-status), Metis and Inuit students).
- Preference will be given to upper-year students.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Complete all sections of this application.
2. Submit proof of Indigenous ancestry (e.g. status card, Metis script or card, family lineage, etc.). If documentation is not currently available, please contact finaid@nipissingu.ca. Note, this documentation will NOT be kept on file.

The CIBC President's Indigenous Achievement Award, value ranges between \$3000-\$5000, is available to Indigenous students, who demonstrate high achievement in disciplines related to Science, Technology, Environmental Science, Math, or Indigenous Studies. Applicants must be registered either full or part time, at Nipissing University in the 2020-2021 academic year. The recipient will be selected based on their personal statement.
